

## AA SCREENING DETERMINATION

In accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended, Irish Water has undertaken Appropriate Assessment screening to assess, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the site, if the project, individually or in combination with other plans or projects is likely to have a significant effect on European Site(s). In this context, particular attention was paid to the European Site(s) listed below:

- Boyne Coast and Estuary SAC (Site Code: 001957),
- River Boyne and River Blackwater SAC (Site Code: 002299),
- Rockabill to Dalkey Island SAC (Site Code: 003000),
- Rogerstown Estuary SAC (Site Code: 000208)
- River Nanny Estuary and Shore SPA (Site Code: 004158),
- Boyne Estuary SPA (Site Code: 004080),
- Skerries Islands SPA (Site Code: 004122),
- River Boyne and River Blackwater SPA (Site Code: 004232)
- Rockabill SPA (Site Code: 004014)

In accordance with Regulation 42(7) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended, **Irish Water has made a determination following screening that an Appropriate Assessment is not required** as the project is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of the sites as European site(s) and **as it can be excluded**, beyond reasonable scientific doubt, in view of best scientific knowledge, on the basis of objective information and in light of the conservation objectives of the relevant European Site(s), **that the proposed activity, individually or in combination with other plans and projects, would be likely to have a significant effect on all other European Site(s) listed above.**

This determination is based on the nature, location, scale and duration of the proposed works.
